## **DEUTERONOMY 6:5-9**

5 You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might. 6 And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart.7 You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise. 8 You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. 9 You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.

# TIPS FOR FAMILY DEVOS:

\*\*Remember: THEY ARE KIDS. They may interrupt. They may lose focus. They may not "get it" in this short devotion time. Continue to talk with them throughout the week.\*\*

1. Start with prayer. Ask God to bless and use this time to draw your family closer to Him.

2. Focus on ONE verse, passage, or point. Keep it simple.

3. Let your kids read God's Word. You may need to go back and reread it for them, but allow them to read

as much as possible.

4. Ask them their thoughts. What does this mean? How can we apply this to our lives? Get them talking.

5. End with prayer! Encourage your children to pray.

Read the passage related to the lesson your children heard or watched yesterday. Create a prayer list and let each person in the family say something they want to pray about this week.

# TUESDAY
